Approval of Minutes

October 10, 2013 minutes were approved.

CSUL Web site

CAM and its subcommittees have a space at <http://csul.net>. Amy will e-mail the list with contact information for minute-takers to post minutes and will also check about how to log into the site.

Non-SUS links

CAM discussed the presence of non-SUS links in the catalog. Examples include proprietary links for Stanford University and Carleton College. The SUS guidelines instruct catalogers to remove such links, but this may be difficult to implement with batch loaded records. BCDS will discuss the issue, and Betsy will add it as an agenda item for the upcoming TSSC meeting.

BCDS charge

Annie asked for CAM input regarding the BCDS charge. With a limited number of subcommittee members, it is challenging to address all aspects of the charge. CAM was not in favor of establishing a new subcommittee, but voiced support for soliciting assistance from librarians and staff outside of CAM and its subcommittees. CAM also encouraged BCDS to seek its guidance on setting priorities when needed.

Issues for TSSC

Amy inquired about issues to take forward to TSSC, but none were suggested at this time.

Liaison and Subcommittee Reports

Authorities Subcommittee

Priscilla reported that the subcommittee has been working closely with Mary Ann. The LCA10 editing guidelines are done and have been passed along to BCDS to include in the SUS guidelines. Following a demo of UPD Y at a subcommittee meeting, Mary Ann set up a sample set in Test and Production, which is being reviewed by subcommittee members. Priscilla also announced that Marielle Verve, UNF Metadata Librarian, will serve as co-chair.

Bibliographic Control and Discovery Subcommittee

Annie reported that BCDS is focusing on two issues currently: 1) OCLC numbers on non-OCLC records and 2) proprietary fields on shared bibs. Further consideration of 856 fields and e-res icons is on hold, but Annie did bring forward a recommendation to eliminate e-res icons for 856 fields with 2nd indicator 1 (version of resource). At Amy's request, Annie will send a message to the list describing the recommendation and a vote will be taken.

Catherine Gardiner announced her upcoming retirement, and all wished her well. She will be missed!
