

CAM Session--- November 13, 2014

1. Approval of the October minutes.
2. CAM Report on the Shared Bib Problems & Issues Task Force: Final Report: CAM response

Two documents were circulated to CAM. One was a complete list of the actions to be taken, and the other was a document intended for TSSC and CSUL which listed only the top 5 vote-getters from the survey. Eleven libraries voted in the survey.

There was a request to make it clear that we feel that all of the actions suggested by the report are important and that we wish to have all of them worked on eventually. It was also suggested that more detail be put in the report as to what role CAM could play in working on the top five vote getters.

Sarah Norris noted that the original report will go out the CSUL along with the CAM report so that the other items can be examined by the Committee.

Amy expressed appreciation for those who voted.

Amy enumerated the reports to go forward to CSUL: the Third and Fourth quarter reports, the CAM response, and a copy of the Strategic Directions for Catalogers adopted in 2009.

We discussed the importance of having good training materials and noted that BCDS is overlooked at this time. Sarah Norris clarified that the documentation was intended for staff working in the catalog and should be user friendly. Three people offered to work on this documentation: Ethan (FAU), Jeanne Piascik, and Susan Heron.
