1. Minutes approved.

2. FCLA Update – Jennifer Kuntz

- Task Force “Future of Academic Libraries” meeting today.
- Report on New Organization is being forwarded to the Legislature and covers governance, services etc. FCLA Managers went to CCLA and CCLA managers will be visiting FCLA in November. There will be additional meetings between the staffs over the next few months as well.
- Single Bib is in test with three Universities.
- Looking at combined ALEPHs project.
- UBBorrow focus on heavy use items and presently testing auto renewals. Looking at additional functionality to select books or cds that are part of books. UBBorrow Management Report presentations will be later this month. Total of over 18K in UBBorrow and ILL clicks on website. Looking at plans beyond UBBorrow.
- FCLA and CCLA utilize the ILL module in ALEPH. Looking at possible combining etc.
- UBBorrow Holiday Plans – No expirations or items due from Dec 19<sup>th</sup> to Jan 8<sup>th</sup>. DLLI issues are at the local level to determine pickups etc. Items may be processed, but will be delayed due to shipping and closures. (Past, Institutions notify TBLC of their closing dates and last day of pickups. DLLI holds books until institutions reopen.)

3. Resource Sharing Task Force – Kristine Shrauger?

- Proposal for UBBorrow and ILL 60 loan periods with 30 day renewals (Recalls allowed).
- Discussion on minimal loan periods before recall. Several were in favor of 21 days + travel with others 30 days. Current tables are set at 7 days for rush and 30 days for regular.
- Will take a survey online to get consensus and everyone’s input.
