### **Subcommittee update (Florida NACO funnel):**

Priscilla Williams is still working with the library at Bok Towers, which is still trying to work out details for OCLC access. She hopes the authorities librarian there will be able to submit authority records soon.

### **FCLA update (Mary Ann O'Daniel)**

#### 1) Task force report

The Future of the Libraries Task Force report should now be in the hands of the chancellors and the legislative committees. The report isn't on the task force website yet, but Mary Ann will notify the list when it is posted. The report includes a recommended timeline for the transition from FCLA and CCLA to NewOrg. Friday of next week (Dec. 9) will be the first small joint meetings of FCLA and CCLA staff to talk about ILL between the SUS and FCS (in Live Oak) and systems administration (Gainesville).

#### 2) CSUL meeting

The CSUL meeting is today (Dec. 1) and they should make a decision on whether & when to move on single bib.

#### 3) Single bib.

There has been a test merge of all 11 universities in the DEV region, which was done so FCLA could look at the technical issues. In this test, the number of bib. records was reduced from about 22 million to about 10 million. FCLA is working on a test merge for everyone to look at (ETA in January).

Priscilla asked progress on cleanup of local authority files in preparation for the merged authority file. Mary Ann said it hasn't been worked on much due to other projects.

Mary Ann said that FCLA is working on how to load bib. records in a single bib. environment. The details may not be worked out until later.

Options were presented to CSUL on the timing of the single bib. merge. These included:

- a) All 11 universities merge in June 2012
- b) The 3 pilot project universities go first in June 2012, and the rest go later
- c) Everyone merges in December 2012 (but we don't know when the hardware will be moving, or how much control FCLA will have)
