CONSER OpCo Report

CONSER Operations Committee reporting was overshadowed by the LC decision to stop establishing Series Authority Records. PCC libraries have drafted a resolution aimed at LC that they are concerned about the timing and the communication of this issue. PCC and its component programs will not be changing policy with LC. They will be undertaking a study for intelligent simplification.

There is movement forward on the issue of digital reproduction models. Debate continues whether reproductions of print (OCLC model) should be recognized by CONSER. There are authentication issues (differing standards) to be worked out, since only CONSER libraries can modify CONSER records.

No other digital matters were discussed.
