Approximately 3,472 linear feet of space could be used in the near future if materials were housed in an offsite storage facility. Shelving that currently houses retrospective issues of bound journals at the Boca Raton Campus could be used for individual and group study areas. Some materials from the Government Documents collection could be moved offsite and the space could be reallocated to expand the collection or the purchase of a special book collection. The library at the Jupiter Campus will also benefit from having immediate access to an offsite storage facility. Bound journals and monographs that are rarely used could be housed offsite to make room for the growth of this collection.
