

Minutes of the CAGER Conference Call
2 August 2005

Attendees: Naomi Young, UF, Acting Chair; Helen Laurence, FAU; Jim Michael, USF; Kim Montgomery, UCF; Mary Ann O'Daniel, FCLA; Sue Wartzok, FIU.

We first reviewed the draft of procedures for assigning ISSN retrospectively through the ISSN network. (See separate document.) Sue questioned why CAGER would be involved when ISSN are only assigned to the print serial; Naomi clarified that the ISSN is assigned to the print record, but can be used on records for a digitized serial in the 776 or simply as a local tracking number.

This led to a discussion of SFX implementation. Jim pointed out that SFX refers exclusively to the print ISSN, so it's important to have that information.

Helen mentioned FAU's project to move non-SFX URLs out of the public record. We discussed whether it was better to put the old URL in a 599 or a subfield *x* in the 856 field. After some experimentation, we determined that either option would work equally well. The URL can be searched in the WSN (Staff notes) index.

In response to a question from Sue, we reviewed LTQF cataloging workflows at our respective institutions.
